### 2018 Electric Transmission & Distribution Annual Inspection Report

#### Transmission & Distribution System Inspection Program Overview

Silicon Valley Power (SVP) annually inspects and/or patrols the entire electric transmission and distribution system serving the City of Santa Clara. The SVP transmission and distribution system is divided up into five regions for the purpose of identifying areas to be either inspected or patrolled. SVP performs an inspection<sup>1</sup> on 20% of the system each year. The remaining 80% of the system is patrolled<sup>2</sup>. Each region contains a unique number of maps illustrating the equipment to be inspected or patrolled. Each map is duplicated to only identify overhead equipment or underground equipment. SVP inspection teams use the maps as a guide to locate each piece of equipment to be inspected or patrolled.
